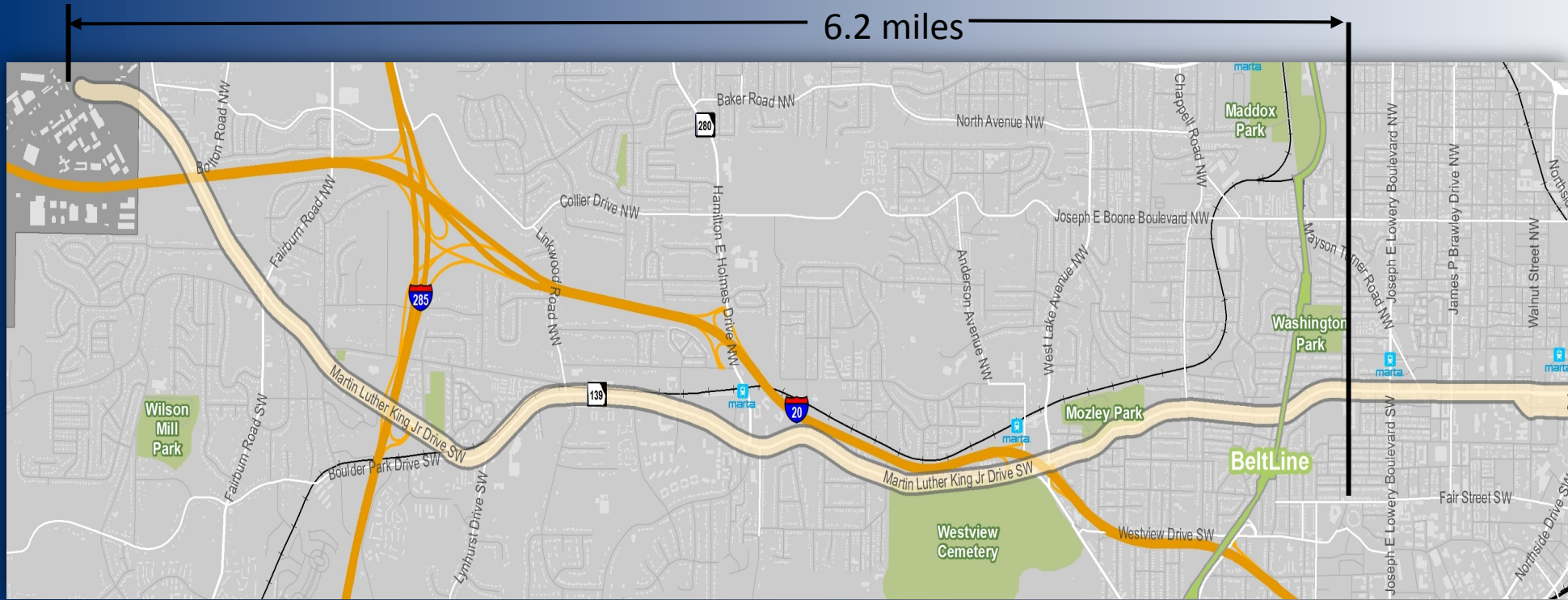

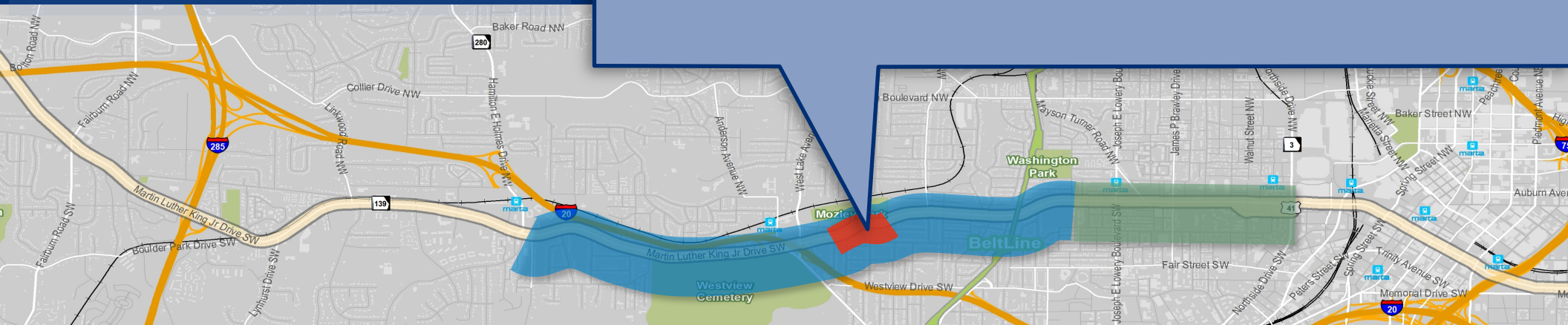


The MLK Jr. Drive Innovation Corridor Project will provide a foundation promoting future investment and development along the entire corridor



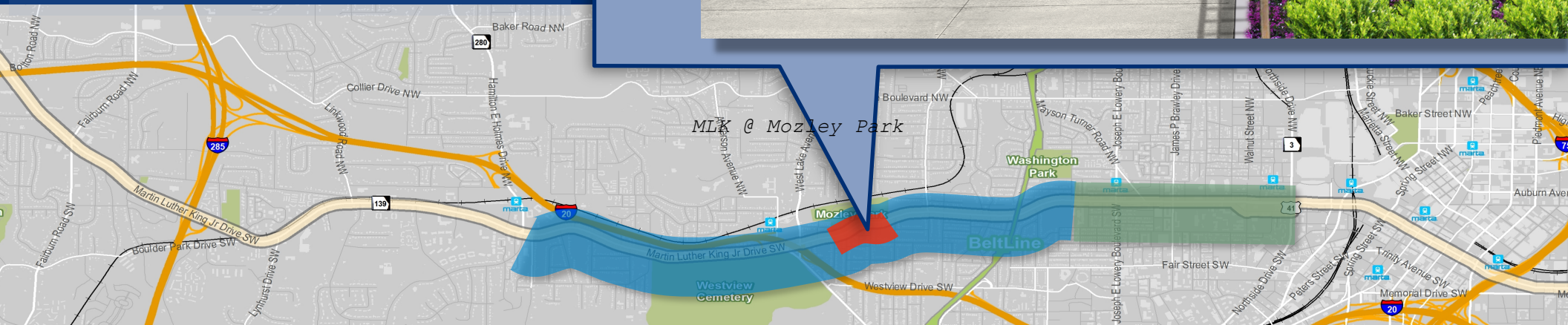
MLK Jr. Drive at Mozley Park Frontage

- Existing MLK Jr. Dr. at Mozley Park frontage



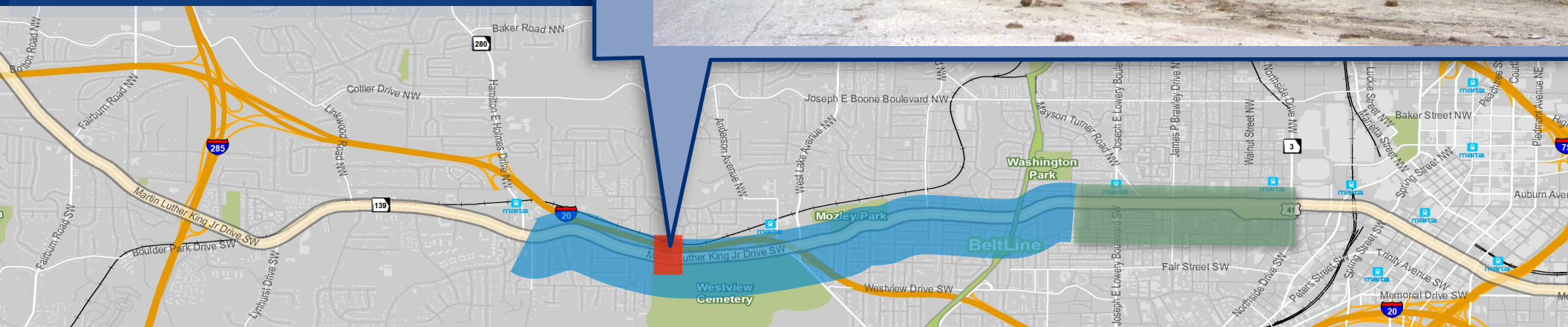

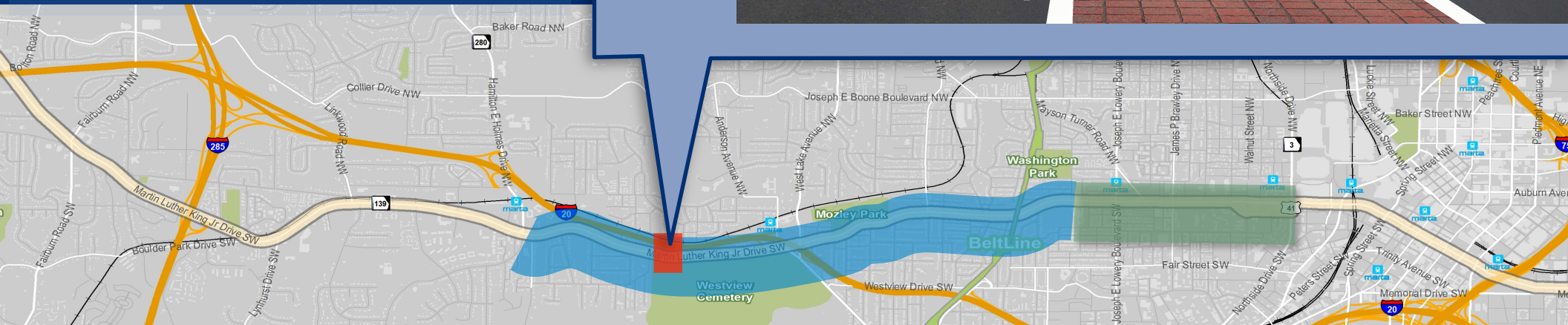


MLK Jr. Drive from Ollie Street to H.E. Holmes Drive

- Mill, resurface, and restripe from Ollie St. to Ralph David Abernathy Blvd.
 - 3 lane section (1 lane each direction & center two-way left turn lane)
 - Bike lanes
 - Shared lane markings on Ollie St. connecting to Lionel Hampton Trail
- New sidewalk, streetscaping, and fencing along Westview Cemetery frontage

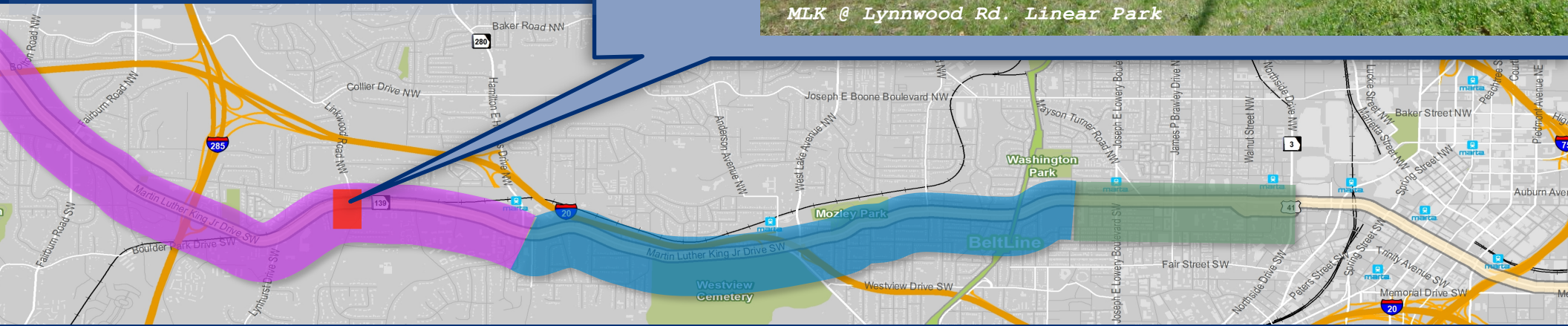


MLK Jr. Drive from Boulder Park Drive to Peyton Place

- Linear park along north side of MLK Jr. Dr. from Boulder Park Dr. to Peyton Pl.

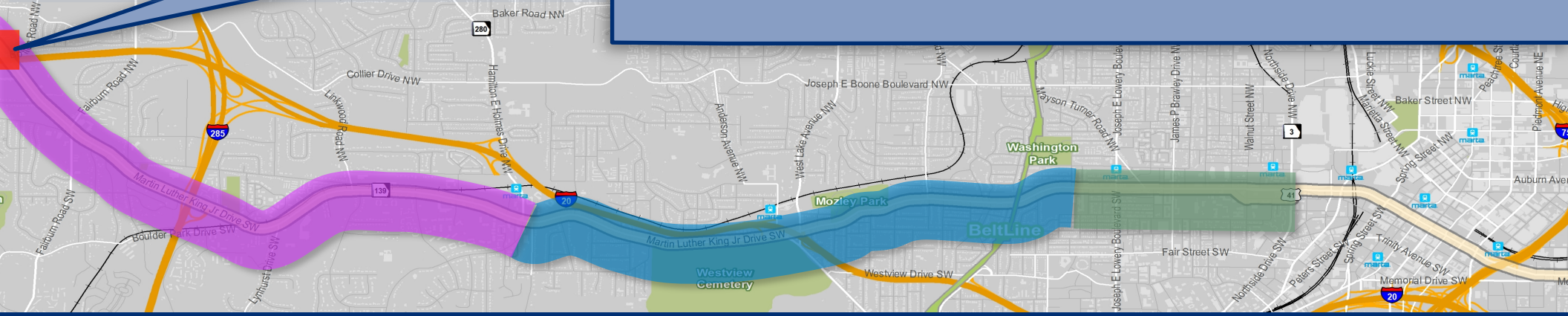

 - Streetscape and mid-block crossing with Rapid Flashing Beacon in front of Adamsville Recreation Center

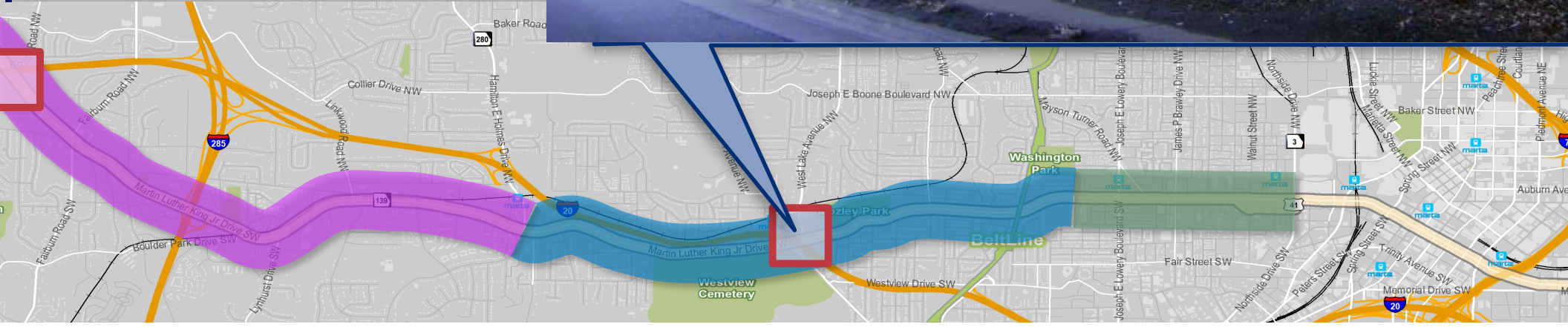


MLK @ Adamsville Rec Center Mid-block crossing



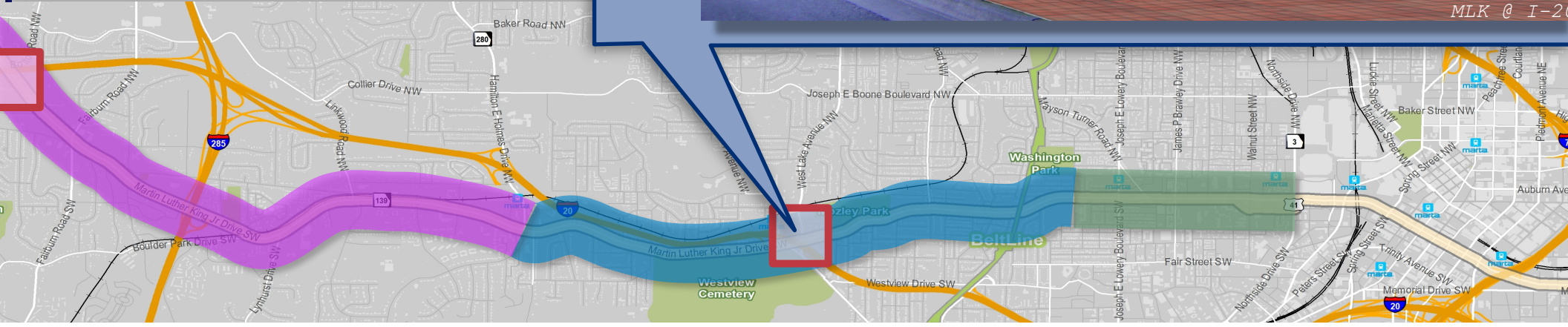
