For months, law enforcement from the GBI, Georgia State Patrol, DNR, Atlanta Police, Dekalb Police, the Fulton County Sheriff's Office, and others have worked day and night to secure the future site of the Atlanta Public Safety Training Center in the face of violent resistance. Domestic terrorists from across the country and globe have illegally camped on this site and harassed law enforcement and civilians, choosing time and again to put destruction and vandalism ahead of legitimate protest. Though many of those harming our community have already been apprehended, those funding and backing their militant activities had avoided facing justice.

These arrests are an important step in ensuring the rule of law is maintained and our streets are safe from those promoting violence. These individuals have financed and supported domestic terrorists' activities with no regard for their impact on those around them. Our state will not stand by while they watch from afar as communities face the destructive consequences of their actions. I commend the GBI, Attorney General's Office, Dekalb D.A., and all others whose efforts have led to the apprehension of these criminal backers. Rest assured, if you endanger the people of Georgia, you will face swift and full justice.
